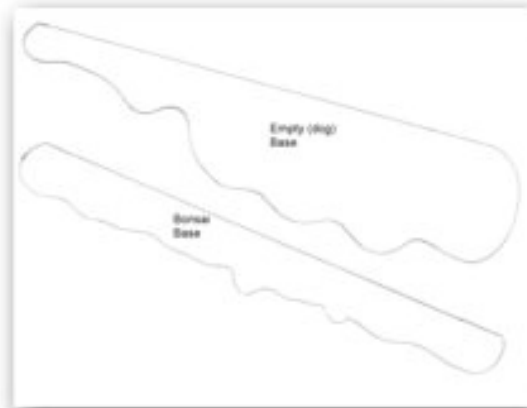
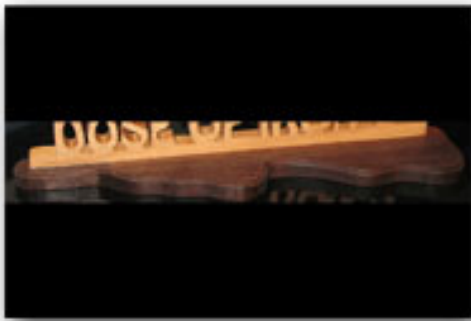


# Free Pattern eBook for Improvised Bases

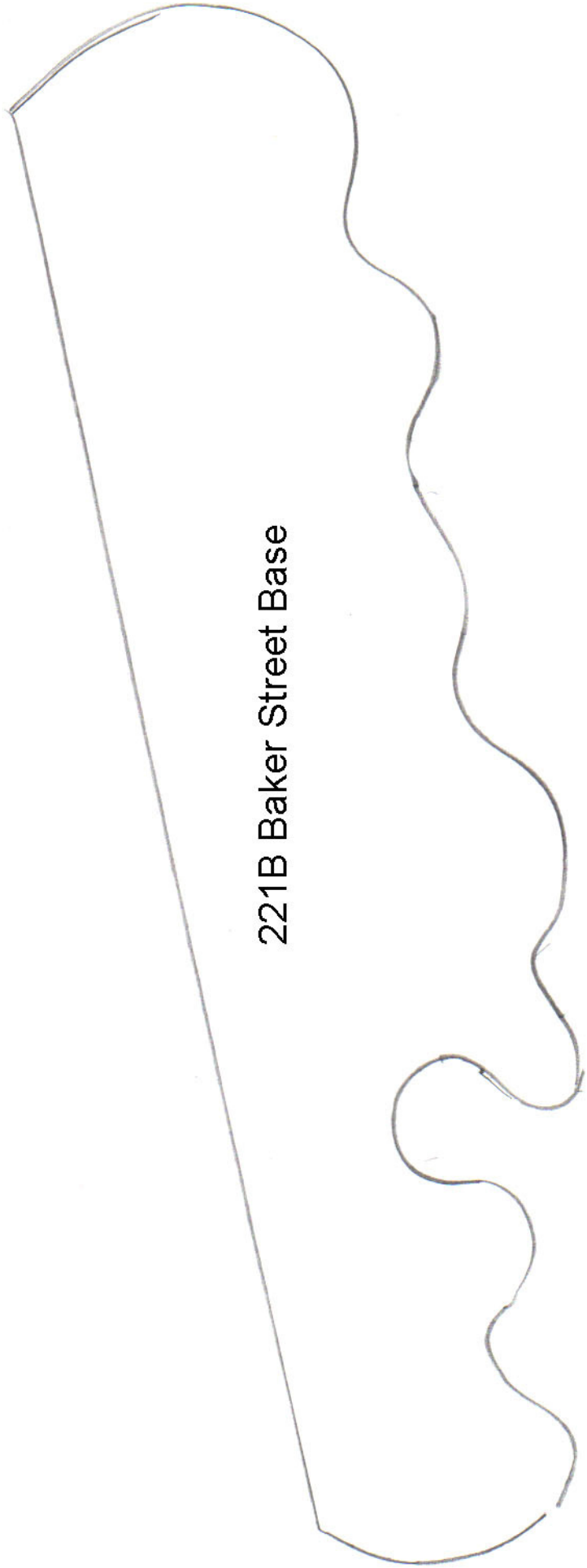
